THE TEACHERS AT THE TOWNHALL



In the morning the teachers went on a tour of the “Bremer Rathaus”, (*English: Town Hall of Bremen*), one of the many cultural heritage sights in Bremen. The town hall consists of two adjacent buildings: the Old Town Hall and the New Town Hall. Construction of the Old Town Hall dates back to the period 1405 to 1409, while the New Town Hall was erected between 1906 and 1913. After the tour they made a quick stop at the famous “Bremer Stadtmusikanten”, (*English: street musicians*) and then headed back to school.



EXPLORING THE “UNIVERSUM”

Today the Delegates were treated with a cultural trip. The students, as well as teachers, could finally blow off a little steam after finishing in their presentations, with a fun cultural activity. They all jumped on the tram after lunch and headed over to the “Universum”, a science center here in Bremen.
